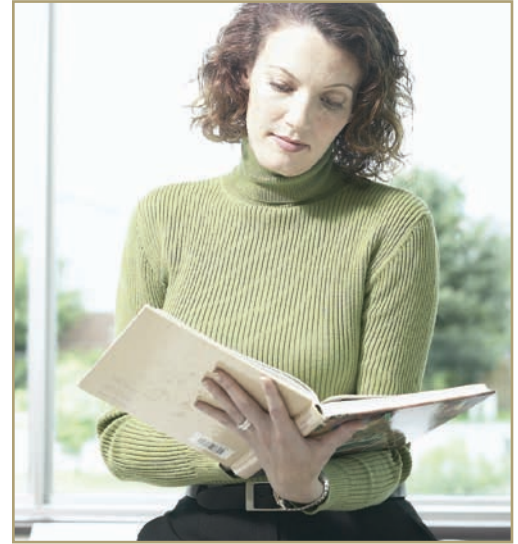

PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT

REQUIRED PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT FOR EDUCATORS

This 13-unit, graduate-level, online certificate program responds to the enormous need for trained reading professionals with expertise in postsecondary settings - particularly at the community college level. This certificate also responds to the national mandate to ensure a quality workforce in postsecondary education, to solidify the purpose and role of appropriate professional preparation, and to continually update the knowledge and skills of those who practice in this field.

This certificate addresses cutting-edge curriculum that corresponds to emerging needs in the profession and is also linked to the California mandate under AB 1725 for community college faculty who have either an MS in Reading or an MS in English with certification in Postsecondary Reading.



Candidates for admission must have completed a BS or BA from an accredited institution having achieved a minimum GPA of 2.5 in the last 60 semester units attempted for that degree.
